Thank you very much for your purchase of Nomblot concrete tanks.

Attached are some very important preparation, usage and maintenance instructions for your review and reference. Please have all staff involved in the use and care of the tanks refer to these instructions before working with the tanks.

One thing we like to emphasize as you get the tank(s) installed is to please make sure every leg is in good contact with the bottom of the tank (or for Eggs and Dolia that all the legs are in good contact with the winery floor). It is very common that at least one leg or foot will need shimming with thin hard plastic, slate or metal. This is necessary for long-term structural integrity of the tanks.

Also, there are 3 extremely important “Don’ts” regarding concrete tanks (these are detailed in the attached protocols):

1. No high pressure rinsing or washing.
2. No high temperature water (nothing higher than 90 degrees Fahrenheit).
3. No citric or other harsh acids for cleaning or sanitizing (only tartaric is approved).

Of course, please don’t hesitate to contact us with any questions that arise as you prep, use and maintain your tank(s). We hope they work well for you and make excellent wine!
