

THE CLAYVER WINERY SYSTEM

The new Clayver cellar system combines practicality, ergonomics, and premium quality. It is available in two versatile and modular configurations: **ARISTEO** and **ATLANTE**.

ARISTEO



ARISTEO is a configuration starting with three Clayver **ORIZZONTE 400L** vessels, offering a total capacity of 1200L, which can be expanded as desired in height and length.

ARISTEO enables the creation of seamless **walls of stoneware vessels** within the cellar. The self-supporting modular stands are **highly versatile, optimizing** cellar space while protecting the tanks from accidental impacts. The rotating system ensures efficient lees stirring and guarantees complete draining through the bung hole.

An ancient deity of ancient Sicily and protector of agriculture, Aristeo was worshipped alongside Dionysus. He was considered the son of Apollo and the nymph Cyrene. Raised by the nymphs, he was taught to cultivate olive trees, handle milk, and tend to beehives. As an adult, he devoted himself entirely to beekeeping. Clayver **ARISTEO**, with its hexagonal stand, evokes the honeycomb structure of beehives.

ATLANTE



ATLANTE is a module consisting of two **ORIZZONTE** vessels of **850L** or **1000L**, providing a total capacity of 1700L or 2000L, which can be expanded as needed. The stacked **ATLANTE** modules are **versatile, optimizing** cellar space while protecting the ceramics from accidental impacts and simplifying their handling. The vessels can be filled and emptied through a drainage valve located on the stainless steel closure lid. Decanting is made easier with the inclusion of a **decanting elbow**, eliminating the need to use a pump through the bung hole. The modules can be used individually or placed side by side to **create a full wall of CLAYVER**.

According to Hesiod, Atlas, also known as Atlante, was one of the Titans who took part in the clash between the Olympians, led by Zeus, and the Titans, commanded by Cronus. After Zeus emerged victorious, he imposed a cruel punishment, casting the Titans into the darkness of Tartarus in the depths of the Underworld. Atlante was condemned to bear the weight of the sky on his shoulders for eternity. Clayver **ATLANTE** evokes the Titan carrying the world upon his shoulders.
